Where Art and Design Meet

▼ The 15th annual Sculpture Objects and Functional Art Fair opens on Friday at the Park Avenue Armory, with more than 50 galleries showing studio art and design, all for sale and open to the public.

"It is art combined with design, and there's so much individual expression and personal vision that comes along in the presentation," said Mark Lyman, who created and founded the show with his wife, Anne Meszko. (Among the items on display will be "Spring Light," right, by Fujinuma Noboru, and "Fauteuil II," below, by Philipp Aduatz.)

The space was reimaged by David Ling, an architect who not only designed the exhibition layout but also created a lighting in-

stallation he describes as a "constellation" based on the Big Bang theory, with boxes of light floating over the space.
